FAQs:

- 1. **Parent Definition:** The term "parent" includes a legal guardian or other person standing in loco parentis (such as a grandparent or stepparent with whom the child lives, or a person who is legally responsible for the child's welfare.
- 2. **Armed Forces Definition:** Armed forces include the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marine Corps, and Coast Guard (10 U.S.C. 101(a)(4)).
- 3. **Active Duty Definition:** Active Duty means full-time duty in the active military service of the United States, including full-time training duty, annual training duty, and attendance, while in active military service, at a school designated as a service school by law (10 U.S.C. 101(d)(1)).
- 4. **Full-time National Guard Duty:** Full-time National Guard Duty means training or other duty (except inactive duty) performed by a member of the Army National Guard or Air National Guard in the member's status as a member of National Guard of a state or territory, Commonwealth of Puerto Rico, or District of Columbia for which the member is entitled to pay or for which the member has waived pay (10 U.S.C. 101(d)(5)).
