## **SWIMMING LESSONS**

### **LEVEL I – Water Exploration**

Skills taught include: full face submerge, experience buoyancy, supported float on front and back, bubble blowing, supported kicking on front and back.

### **LEVEL II – Primary Skills**

Skills taught include: front float unsupported, back float unsupported, front and back float with kick, crawl stroke, elementary back stroke, retrieve objects, and treading with a life jacket

### **LEVEL III – Stroke Readiness**

Skills taught include crawl stroke with rotary breathing, elementary backstroke, underwater swim, retrieving of objects, introduction to sidestroke and breast stroke, diving from side of pool, treading water without flotation.

### **LEVEL IV – Stroke Development**

Skills taught but not limited to: stroke improvement, using breast, side, and back crawl, and elementary backstroke. Also, we will do experimentation with buoyancy and floating positions.

### **LEVEL V: Stroke Refinement**

Skills taught but not limited to: alternate breathing, stride jump entry, beginning diving progress and standing dive from board, long shallow dive, breast stroke, swimming under water, front and back crawl stroke, treading, and diving rules.

### **LEVEL IVI: Skill Proficiency**

Skills taught but not limited to: approach and hurdle on diving board, final proficiency of all swimming strokes, speed turns and flip turns from front crawl stroke, surface dives and help and huddle positions used in cold water survival.
