


As in the past, the summer library program (SLP) here in Benton has two parts:

**SUMMER READING LOG**—simply read—anywhere, anytime—plus visit the Benton Public Library three times during open hours (see below) between **June 5 and July 22**. This incentive program is for *all* children and youth (0-18 years old). Participants keep track of their reading on their reading logs (available in June) and earn prizes. Prizes may be collected at the library after individual goals are met; last day to complete the log and collect prizes is Sat. July 22

*Note: Children do NOT need to come to any story/activity programs to participate in this reading incentive program.*

**Driver Education Program Requirements and Information**

- ☛ If you miss more than one day you must drop the class.
- ☛ Thirty hours of classroom instruction. ***Attendance is mandatory for the entire class and 30 hours of instruction.***  
**BTW**
- ☛ Six hours of behind-the-wheel instruction
- ☛ **\$60.00** is charged for any missed driving lessons.
- ☛ Driving instruction will begin after the behind-the-wheel fee of **\$380.00** is paid
- ☛ ***Permit applications will be distributed to students by Mr. Kern after payment of behind-the-wheel fee***
- ☛ Mr. Kern will schedule driving lessons for all eligible students.
- ☛ ***COMPLETION CERTIFICATES*** will be electronically submitted to the DMV once students are completed with both classroom and behind-the-wheel phases of Driver Education.

If none of these dates or times are convenient for you, there is an on-line course available that meets the classroom state requirements. The fee for the class is **\$125.00** with an additional fee of **\$380.00** for behind-the-wheel instruction.
